ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! God gave us the best gift ever, and His name is Jesus."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You just doesn't seem enough for the gift You have given us in Your Son, Jesus. Knowing that Jesus wants to be my friend forever and [name of child]'s friend forever is the best news ever!"



Drive Time

While on the go, take turns talking about some of the favorite gifts you've ever received and what made them so special. End by saying: "Jesus is God's gift to you and me and everyone in the world. Jesus is special because Jesus is God's Son, and Jesus wants to be our friend forever!"



Bath Time

Add several toy people/animals/action figures and a plastic container to bath time. Encourage your child to give everyone a bath and then put everyone in the container. (Try to say the word "everyone" as much as possible.) When they are done, talk about how God gave Jesus as a gift to EVERYONE!
